

Insights – What is Truth? (2 John & 3 John)

Key Verses: 2 John 2; John 14:6

Talk Summary:

Today we are increasingly confronted by the contradictions between internal reality/truth and external reality/truth. What is truth?

Truth is a person – Jesus. (John 14:6)
He says, "You will know the truth and the truth will set you free" (John 8:32)

 - Where do we get our morals from?
 - Where do we get our identity and worth from?
 - Love in the truth is practical hospitality
- 3. We persevere in the truth

Worship

Worship is not just singing, it is thanking God for who he is and what he has done and is lived out through a life of trusting obedience. Discussing this together is an act of worship.

• What has God been speaking to you about this week? (Go around the group quickly don't spend a long time on it)

Discussion Questions (choose some which are most relevant to your group)

- How do you experience communication with Jesus Christ? subjective relationship, the Bible, friends, sermons, podcasts, ...?
- Jesus says, 'You will know the truth and the truth will set you free.' How have you experienced that in your life?
- What influences you in deciding what moral standards you will follow? Friends, society, social media, television, films, intuition, Bible, sermons, podcasts, ...? How positive or negative have these influences been?
- Where do you get your sense of worth and identity from? Friends, society, social media, television, films, intuition, Bible, sermons, podcasts, ...? How positive or negative have these influences been?
- How can you tell if somebody is a deceiver? How can you tell if news or information is real or fake? Does it matter?
- The reward for persevering is experiencing grace mercy and peace from God. How do you experience grace, mercy and peace in your life?

Witness - How would you share what you have learned with a non-church friend?

We want to be investing in authentic relationships with those who don't know Jesus yet and inviting them to anything where they might meet other Christians and Jesus. Pick one of the below each week:
