Jesus knew that some of the people were shouting 'Hosanna' would soon be shouting 'Crucify Him'. He knew Judas would betray him, Peter would deny him and that in less than 40 years, the city he loved would be pretty much destroyed.

He had fed the hungry, healed the sick, raised the dead and forgiven sins. Yet for the most part he had been rejected in his own city (John 1:11).
