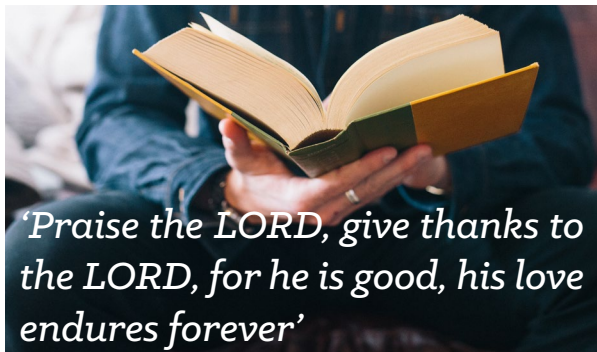

Psalm 136:2-3; 1 Chronicles 16:8-9 & Psalm 7:17

Give thanks to God for what he has done

Give thanks to God for his love, goodness and faithfulness

Psalm 118:1; Psalm 138:2; Jeremiah 33:11; 1 Corinthians 1:9

Give thanks to God for our daily provision, answer to prayer and for others

PRAYER TOOL FOR FAMILIES

Resources: Old magazines, newspapers and/or pictures printed off the internet. A large piece of paper or card and glue sticks.

Write 'God thanks for...' on the top of your piece of card. Cut out pictures together that remind you of things you are thankful for. Then as you stick each one onto the card say out loud: 'God thanks for...[whatever it is]' When you finish, hold hands, look into the eyes of each person and say, God thanks for [their name].
